- Original research work will be preferred for oral presentation.
- All abstracts will be screened by an expert panel for Oral / Poster presentation.


ABOUT KNMH



KAMALA NEHRU MEMORIAL HOSPITAL & REGIONAL CANCER CENTRE, PRAYAGRAJ

The leading charitable hospital of Uttar Pradesh, committed to providing affordable, State of the Art, Comprehensive healthcare to all sections of society, with unceasing quality and safety, blending innovation and teaching as an integral part of patient care.

The sprawling green campus, spread over a 17 acre estate, is located in the heart of Prayagraj neighbouring Swaraj Bhawan and Anand Bhawan, home of India's freedom movement.



KNMH traces it's root to the Freedom struggle, when in the year 1931, Smt. Kamala Nehru converted some rooms in Swaraj Bhawan into a congress dispensary.

Presiding over it all was Kamala ji herself, a woman frail in health but indomitable in spirits, giving her time, labour and overall compassion till her untimely death in 1936.

JOURNEY OF RCC KNMH

Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru on his birthday, 14th November 1943 announced for the establishment of a Cancer Wing in the Hospital similar to TATA Memorial Hospital, Bombay.

- The Begum Abdul Kalam Azad Memorial Wing was inaugurated by Shri R. Rajagopalchari, the Government General of India
 in 1949.
- The year 1949 marked the beginning of the Cancer treatment at the hospital with the installation of Maximar Deep X- Ray therapy unit for cancer therapy.
- Government of Uttar Pradesh in 1956 released grant towards construction of buildings and separate matching grant for the purchase of Radium source, equipments etc. for the Cancer wing.
- The Cancer wing of the hospital was formally inaugurated by the Vice President of India Dr. S. Radhakrishnan on April 8, 1959 with three Deep X- Ray units, one Cobalt Unit and 200mg Radium for Brachytherapy. This made KNMH the third centre in the country for comprehensive cancer treatment in the early fifties, the other two being TATA Memorial Hospital, Mumbai and Chitranjan National Cancer Hospital, Kolkata.
- A modernization program of the cancer wing was initiated in 1983.

Silent feature of the Development in 80s Included:

- 1. Installation of the Stationary head Janus Cobalt Unit in 1984.
- Commissioning of Rotational Head Isocentric Teletherapy Unit, Theratron 780 C Selectron LDR (Remote control after Loading) with Cesium 137 Source.
- In 1993, the Department of Atomic Energy co- opted this Hospital as a Center for Research in Radiation Oncology, Medical Physics and Nuclear Medicine.
- On the strength of services rendered by the Hospital, Government of India recognized KNMH as a Regional Cancer Center in 1994.
- In 2014, the Regional Cancer Center got the status of State Cancer Institute by Ministry of Health & Family welfare, GOI.
- The hospital has Post Graduation teaching facility, recognized by the National Board of Examinations for Diplomate of National Board (DNB) in Radiation Oncology and Obstetrics & Gynaecology.
- Modernization efforts started in the year 2012 by introducing Quality Controls has yielded NABH accreditation to the hospital
 in February 2019. A dedicated 12 bedded ward started for Pediatric oncology (Jawahar Ward) with free bed & diet with highly
 subsidized treatment.
- Hospital joined hand with National Center for Disease information & Research (Indian Council of Medical Research) National Cancer Registry Program, Bengluru to start various research projects, Hospital based cancer registry (2014), Population based Cancer Registry (2018).
- Currently Department is equipped with state of the art LINACs, one Truebeam & two Halcyon, one Telecobalt Unit and HDR Microselectron Brachytherapy Unit.

ANAND BHAWAN

His historic and magnificent house museum in Allahabad focuses primarly on the entire Nehru family.

This Bhawan had served as the residence for this family when their original mansion of Swaraj Bhawan was changed completely into the local headquarters for the Indian National Congress.

A WALK IN A COMPANY GARDEN

Your tour to Allahabad will remain incomplete if you don't go for a peaceful and soul enriching walk in the company garden. To commemorate the life lain by Chandra Shekhar Azad in this park, a statue has been erected inside the park.




THE NEW YAMUNA BRIDGE

Is a cable stayed bridge. The bridge runs North - South across the Yamuna river connecting the city of Prayagraj to its neighborhood of Naini. The construction was consulted by COWI A/S, a Danish consulting company.

Main construction was done by Hyundai and was successfully completed in 2004.

KHUSRU BAGH

This is a magnificent burial complex. This Bagh is known for its unique tombs of Shah Begum and Khusrau Mirza among other important family members. This Bagh comes under the list of Indian site of National Importance. There are neatly drawn, lush green gardens dotting the entire are and giving this place a look of immense serenity.





RELIGIOUS ATTRACTIONS




TRIVENI SANGAM

One of the holiest destinations for the Hindus, the Triveni Sangam is perhaps the most important place to visit in Prayagraj. Confluence of three Rivers Ganga, Yamuna & Saraswati (A mythical river which is supposed to have dried up thousands of year ago).

Incidentally, Maha Kumbh which comes after every 12 years, will follow this kumbh of Oncologist and all will have an opportunity to visit this auspicious place during the conference. The Sangam truly comes alive during the mahakumbh, attracting the devout from all across the country.

THE HOLY ALL SAINTS CATHEDRAL

Allahabad is known for its rich Hindu cultural heritage. However, it is also houses a beautiful church which is located on MG marg. If you looking to spend some time away from hustle and bustles of the temples and Ghats then a visit here, it will definitely evoke a sense of tranquility and serenity within your heart & soul.





SHANKAR VIMAN MANDAPAM

It is 130 feet high and is loacted in proximity to Triveni. It is a fourstoried structure that houses the idols of Kumari Bhatt, Jagatguru Shankaracharya and Kamaksha Devi.

HANUMAN MANDIR

One of the unique temples in th city is located in proximity to the Allahabad Fort The idol of Hanuman is 20feet long and 8 feet wide. This idol is in a reclining position and is a few feet below the ground. Along with 108 Shivalingas. Hanuman Temple is tallest temple in Jhusi.
